

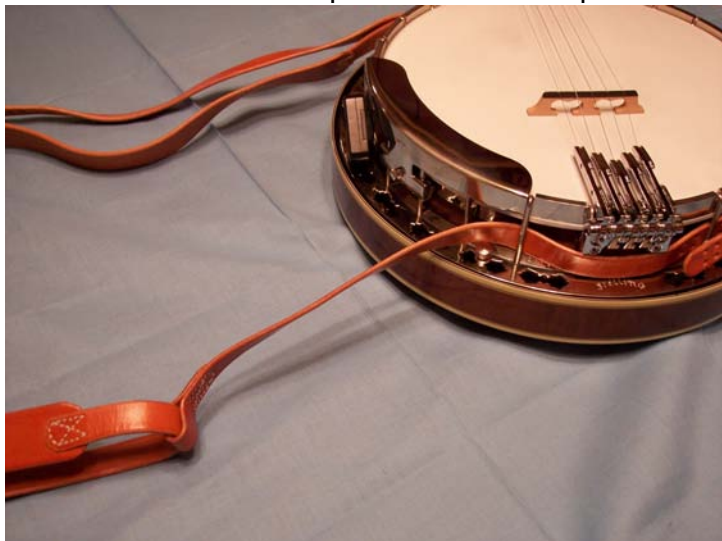
# Thanks so much for purchasing the Van Lear Banjo Strap!

Here are a few tips for attaching the strap to your banjo:



If you need to open up the adjustment holes to make it easier to thread the leather thongs, try using the enclosed golf tees!

This is the cradle strap end with a strap sewn onto it. It is mounted toward the neck side of the pot.

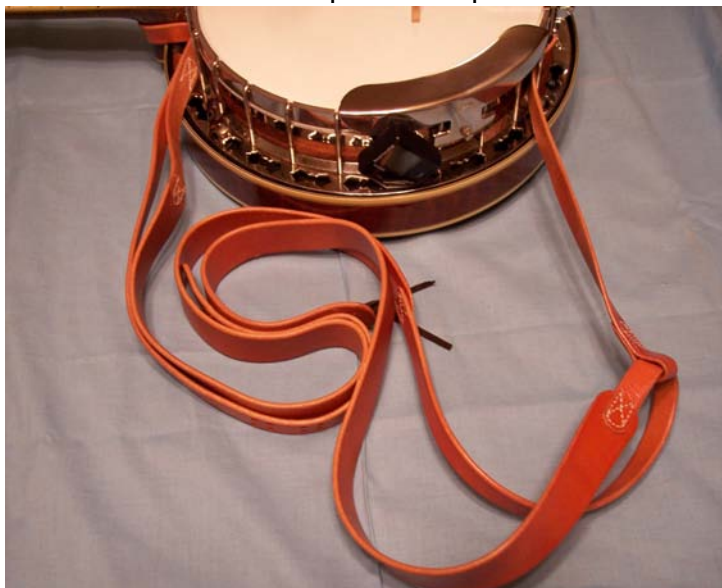


If you should find that you need additional adjustment holes in your strap to make it fit perfectly, we'll be happy to put them in for you. Please mark the areas where you want more holes, send it back to us, and we'll punch them there AND the surrounding area. We'll make sure you get the fit you want.

This is the cradle strap that loops onto the shoulder strap. It mounts on the tailpiece side of the pot.



When using the two points of adjustment to make the strap fit perfectly for you, **PLEASE use the knot it was tied with when you received it.** This is a harness knot that **WILL NOT** come loose.

## How to switch from straight to criss-cross

The piece of strap with the sliding loop should be at the tailpiece end of your banjo. The point where two pieces are sewn together, one on top of the other, is towards the neck.

1. Reach behind your neck with your left hand to where the adjustment lacing is joining those two pieces.



2. Pull the top strap over and in front of your head, with both hands on a big loop in front of your face.
3. Put your left arm through this loop and put the loop over your right shoulder.
